This privacy policy sets out how Tiny Tasters LTD uses and protects any information that you give Tiny Tasters LTD when you use this website.

Tiny Tasters LTD is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website, you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

Tiny Tasters LTD reserves the right, at its discretion, to make changes to any part of the Website, the Information or these Terms. Tiny Tasters LTD may change this policy from time to time by updating this page. It is important you check this page from time to time to ensure that you are happy with any changes.

This policy is effective from September 2019. By continuing to use the Website you agree to be bound by these Terms as amended.

What we collect

We may require basic information which identifies you as an individual ("Personal Information"), such as your name, email address and phone number, in order to enable you to take advantage of particular services that we offer, for example when you send us a question / request from our "Contact Us" page, or further information on a specific service. We will only use such Personal Information for the purposes of providing information which you have requested, or for other purposes set out in these Terms.

We may collect the following information:

- Name and job title;
- Company or organisation;
- Contact information, including email address and telephone number(s);
- Demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests;
- Other information relevant to customer surveys and/or offers; and
- Information pertinent to fulfilling our services on an individual's or organisation's behalf.

What we do with the information we gather

We require this information for the purpose of:

- Internal record keeping;
- Contacting you for market research purposes. We may contact you by email, telephone or post.

If you do not wish us to make use of your Personal Information in this way, please email lyndsay@tiny-tasters.com. We will also give you the opportunity to opt out of future marketing whenever we send you marketing material. You can also opt out at any time by contacting us.

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place highly encrypted electronic systems and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site or page. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences. Tiny Tasters LTD use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about webpage traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.
