



## Tiny Tasters Disclaimer

Welcome to Tiny Tasters!

We would like all of our tiny tasters and their grown up to have fun in our sessions and in order to do so, we must ensure everyone's safety. Please read the following information before the session to ensure you understand your responsibility towards keeping your own and other children safe.

- The adult responsible for the child is solely responsible for the child throughout Tiny Tasters sessions.
- It is the responsibility of the adult responsible for the child to let the session leader know of any allergies the child may have, prior to the session.
- It is the responsibility of the adult responsible for the child to let the session leader know of any medical issues or treatment the child may require, prior to the session.
- It is the responsibility of the adult responsible for the child to assist the child throughout the session, supporting with the use of potentially dangerous equipment eg. scissors, knives, grater, peeler, can opener, oven, hob, glass, kettle and any electrical equipment.
- Where hot drinks may be consumed, it is the responsibility of the adult responsible for the child to keep this out of reach of all children.
- The surface where we work may become slippery therefore extra care must be taken.
- Craft activities may involve paints or materials where precaution is necessary to ensure harm does not come to your child.
- Adults and children need to wear comfortable clothing which you are not concerned about getting dirty, wet or stained.
- It is the responsibility of the adult responsible for the child to inform the session leader if you **DO NOT WISH FOR PHOTOGRAPHS TO BE TAKEN** and later used for marketing purposes (social media, flyers). A consent form will be made available before the first session, which you will be asked to complete and sign straight away.
